# Privacy policy and GDPR compliance

We've updated our Privacy policy to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), which comes into effect across Europe from 25 May 2018.

#### What do we hold?

As a supplier, we only hold personal data about you and your company that is necessary for carrying out our normal business activities. This information may include a name, address, email addresses and other work and personal contact information as provided to us by you or your company. In some cases, we may hold bank account details for efficient payment or receipt of monies due.

#### Why do we need it?

#### How do we store it?

We may store your personal data in the following places:

Some data is stored on Mailchimp, a system which is operated and protected in the USA.

#### What do we do with it?

All personal data is processed in the UK by us and our suppliers and only in connection with our ongoing business relationship. Third parties, suppliers and others involved in our normal business dealings have access to your personal data only to perform the role they fulfil in the overall process. Our company does not transfer your data out of the European Union, unless we are exporting products to countries outside the EU, in which case, data will be shared with them as required.
